WEATHER GUIDE

Typical temps	Humidity	Rain risk	Quick tip
27 – 36 °C (81 – 97 °F) midday; ~25 °C at night	70 - 85 %	Frequent afternoon showers & the occasional typhoon tail	Light, breathable clothing + a packable umbrella or rain poncho



Heat Index: Shanghai's UV index often hits 9–10. A small fold-up fan or minimister can be a life-saver on the long outdoor queues to enter SNIEC.

PACKING TIPS

- Light Layers: Quick-dry tees, linen shirts, and a light jacket for cold metro AC.
- Rain Gear: Compact umbrella and thin poncho; hotel umbrellas are bulky.
- Footwear: Breathable sneakers for concrete floors and extensive walking.
- Gadgets:
 - Pack a power bank with the "3C/CCC" safety logo to avoid confiscation at Chinese security checkpoints after June 2025; non-Chinese brands are exempt.

- USB-C + USB-A cables
- Type I plug adaptor (China uses 220 V, Type A threeflat-pin or two-pin)
- Med kit: Electrolytes, bandaids, antihistamine, and your prescription meds in original bottles.
- Cash buffer: ¥300-¥500 in small bills for rare cash-only vendors or taxi backup.

BEFORE YOU GO



Save key addresses in Chinese.

Security guards, taxi drivers, and most Didi drivers still prefer Chinese characters.

Copy/paste or print the venue address:

上海新国际博览中心 (SNIEC), 龙阳路 2345 号, 浦东新区.

Tip: Put hotel & embassy addresses into Apple Maps offline list for one-tap routing.

2 Set up mobile payments (Do this at home])

China runs on mobile payments: cash is rarely used and small vendors may have no change, so linking your card to Alipay / WeChat Pay before you land avoids in-country SMS hassles and lets you ride the metro, grab a Didi, and scan-to-pay from day one.





3 Lock-in Data & VPN

Set up a China-ready international **eSIM** before you fly. Or, if you'll buy a local **China Unicom/China Mobile SIM**, pre-install and test **VPN apps** at home.


